# **Technical Speaker Topic:** Ultra Low NOx Burner Protection



Bob graduated from Pennsylvania State University in 1991 with a degree in Petroleum & Natural Gas Engineering. He has lived and worked in Bakersfield, California, as a summer-hire roustabout and then engineer for Mobil Oil for two summers. Bob has been working in the California Oil & Gas industry continuously since 1998 as either a manufacturer's representative or manufacturer sales person. He is currently the Western Region Sales Manager for PECOFacet Filtration Products, with his office in




