As Co-Founder of The Joyful Child Foundation as well as The Surviving Parents Coalition (SPC), and a member of the Board of Directors for the National Association to PROTECT Children, Erin has become a highly respected spokesperson, spreading her message in frequent media appearances, keynote addresses, and presentations for both government and private organizations. In an effort to reach every child with safety education, Erin developed a train-the-trainers Ambassador program for adult education for child protection, and the BRAVE Programs with a comprehensive Kindergarten - 12th grade supplemental physical education and health curriculum with ten personal safety and life-skills lessons as well as 90-minute workshops for community-based agencies. Erin delivers an inspiring message of hope and courage that motivates audiences to be a part of the solution to stop crimes against children.

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
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
