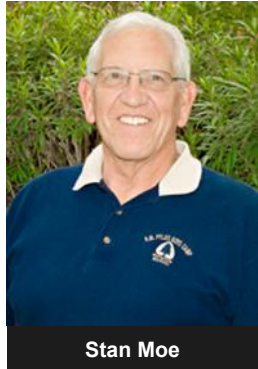


Topic: Pyle's Boys Camp

The Designing for Corrosion Control Course reviews the principles of corrosion and corrosion control and provides a systematic method for applying the technology of corrosion prevention to the design process. It also covers the economic considerations of including corrosion control in system design and the financial principles used in evaluating alternative materials and designs. No prior training is required. However, for those with a limited corrosion background, the NACE Basic Corrosion Course is recommended prior to taking this course. The course is held 8-5 Mon - Thurs, with a comprehensive open-book exam on Fri morning.

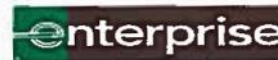

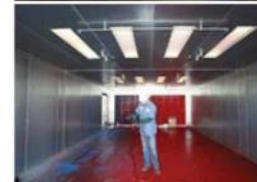

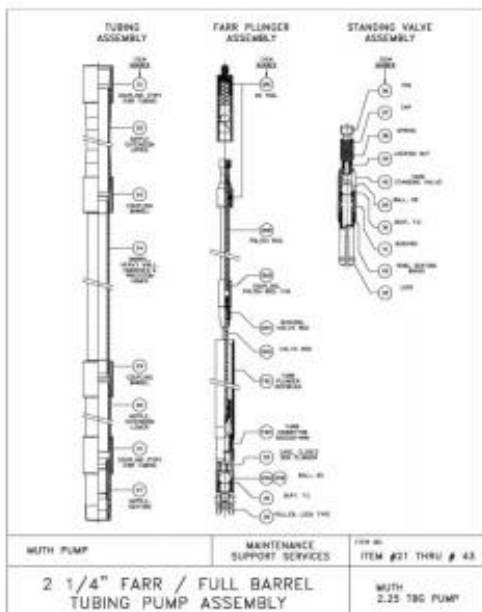
